### The sooner you take Plan B, the better it works

Plan B is an emergency contraception you take within 72 hours when:

- You didn't use any form of birth control and had unprotected sex
- There was an issue with your regular birth control method (eg, the condom broke or slipped)
- You missed a dose (or more) of your regular birth control pill and had sex

### What Plan B is

Plan B is emergency contraception you take within 72 hours after unprotected sex.

- Helps prevent pregnancy before it starts by temporarily delaying ovulation—so there's no egg to meet the sperm
- No ID, no Rx, no age requirement—no matter where you buy it
- Won't hurt your chances of getting pregnant in the future

### What Plan B isn't

A few important things to keep in mind when you're considering taking Plan B:

- It is **not** an abortion pill
- It won't affect an existing pregnancy
- It is not meant to be used as a regular birth control method
